Mrs Raynham will be leaving us this Friday to begin her retirement.

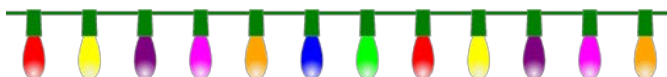

I'm sure you will join with me in wishing Mrs Raynham a long and happy retirement.

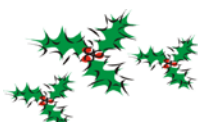
This Week:
